THE BASICS

Located in the rocky midcoast of [Maine](#), Sebasco Harbor Resort is a piece of New England history preserved. The storied, 79-year-old family-minded establishment, founded by the bakery magnate Nate Cushman and frequented by the likes of [Eleanor Roosevelt](#), continues to woo guests with its untouched-by-time waterfront setting and a slate of activities that bring to mind the pleasures of yesteryear, from lobster bakes to lawn bowling. But since being taken over by new ownership in 1997, the 550-plus-acre, 133-room resort has also aimed to appeal to more contemporary-minded vacationers, with updated lodgings, a high-end restaurant and activities like weekly wine tastings. The newest addition, part of the \$12 million overhaul, is the Fairwinds Spa, which opened last year.
